COVID INSTANT ORDER -83 A

The Government of Andhra Pradesh has undertaken several measures including strengthening of surveillance for prevention, containment, and control of COVID-19. After an intensive activity to control and contain Coronavirus the State has reached a stage where the number of cases are declining on a day to day basis.

However, to further reduce the spread of infection building awareness in the community on COVID appropriate behaviour is very critical. In this direction the Government has issued G.O RT.NO.520 cited at reference above for intensified IEC/BCC activities to contain and control COVID and detailed Standard Operating Procedures with IEC protocols have also been issued as COVID Instant Order 83 dated 13/10/2020.
