COVID-19 Care Centre

Admission Criteria

All the below three (3) criteria should be satisfied:

- 1. RT-PCR COVID-19 positive status
- 2. Oxygen saturation >or= 94% on room air
- 3. Mild disease with high risk for severe disease or mortality like:
 - a. Age >60 years
 - b. Cardiovascular disease, Hypertension & CAD
 - c. Diabetes Mellitus & Immunocompromised states
 - d. Chronic lung/kidney/liver disease
 - e. Obesity

Requisite Facilities

- 1. Round the clock a doctor is to be available in the CCC
- 2. Round the clock paramedical staff & support staff are to be available
- 3. Requisite medicines are to be available
- 4. Basic health monitoring equipment like Pulse oximeter, BP apparatus, Thermometer etc.
- 5. Map the CCC to nearest COVID-19 hospital
- 6. Ambulance facility to shift the patient in case of need
 - a. Emergency Oxygen is to be available

Discharge criteria

Criteria 1 & 2 together or criteria 3 alone.

1. Resolution of symptoms

AND

2. Oxygen saturation is maintained >94% for 3 consecutive days without oxygen support

OR

3. Attending doctor clinically evaluates & decides on discharge

Post-Discharge

- 1. At the time of discharge, patients will be advised to isolate themselves at home and self-monitor their health duly following Home Isolation protocol.
- 2. Home Isolation monitoring through local ANM and PHC Medical Officer is to be taken up
- 3. To contact 104 call centre for any information or services related COVID-19

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
