Sub: Safe keeping of Inj. Remdesivir vials for audit

As per reference 1 cited above, the Government of AP has communicated the guidelines for usage of Inj. Remdesivir to the COVID-19 patients. As per reference 2 cited above, the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for use of Remdesivir by designated COVID-19 hospitals (private) was issued. As per reference 3 cited above, District level flying squads were formed.

It is further instructed that after usage of every vial of Inj. Remdesivir, the empty vial is to be preserved duly following Infection prevention measures in the hospital. This shall be verified during daily Remdesivir audit by the Hospital Superintendent. Further, the used empty vials shall be made available for verification to District level flying squads during their inspections. After the audit is completed to the satisfaction of the authorities, the injection Remdesivir vials are to be disposed off duly following Bio Medical Waste Management and Infection Prevention Measures.
