- A. The District Collectors are requested to constitute "District Expert Committee on COVID-19 which includes specialists from Pulmonary Medicine, General Medicine, Anaesthesiology, Radio Diagnosis, Microbiology, Social & Preventive Medicine and any other resource person found suitable
- B. The District Collectors are requested to ensure similar Committee is in place for every COVID-19 hospital
- C. The District Collectors are requested to constitute "District Committee on COVID-19 death audit" and take necessary action as per the Committee proceedings. The Committee shall be as follows:

a. District Collector - Chairman

b. JC Development - Member convener

c. DMHO - Member

d. DCHS - Member

e. Concerned COVID-19 hospital Superintendent - Member

- f. Any other member nominated by the District Collector
- D. Roles & Responsibilities of the Expert Committees:

I. State Expert Committee

- 1. To inspect, supervise & guide Government hospitals and other hospitals dedicated to COVID-19
- 2. To advise on Clinical Protocols
- 3. Implementation of National protocol on treatment
- 4. To conduct sample death audits at state level on every Wednesday at 12 PM
- 5. To arrange seminars/webinars on various subjects of importance to COVID-19 practitioners

- 6. Report to Spl. CS, HM&FW every Monday
- 7. In the form of presentation compare weekly trends & suggest actionable points

II. Zonal Expert Committee

- 1. To review one District Expert Committee everyday
- 2. Report to State Expert Committee once a week

III. District Expert Committee

- 1. Implementation of National protocol on COVID-19 treatment
- 2. To ensure that the National protocol is available to every COVID-19 health practitioner & in the hospital (Emergency room, wards, ICU etc.) for ready reference and action
- 3. To conduct Death audit hospital wise
- 4. Implementation of Infection prevention protocol in the hospitals & attached labs
- 5. To ensure Expert committees are formed in every COVID-19 Hospital
- 6. To arrange "COVID-19 CMEs" in a systematic & structured manner duly including following broad disciplines
 - a. Emergency care & Pulmonology
 - b. Cardiology & Immunology
 - c. Intensive care
 - d. Microbiology, Biochemistry & Infection control
 - e. Obstetrics & Gynaecology and Paediatrics
 - f. Social & Preventive medicine
