Admission Guidelines for COVID-19 Hospitals


RT-PCR COVID-19 Positive with any one of the following criteria

1. Breathlessness and/or cough, cardinal symptoms like Fever, Sore throat, Headache, Myalgias, Diarrhoea etc. with Respiratory rate ≥ 30 per minute and Oxygen Saturation $< 94\%$ on Room air.
2. Oxygen saturation $< 94\%$ on Room air.
3. With uncontrolled comorbidities.
4. With raised inflammatory markers.
5. Patients who are duly referred from home isolation and covid care centres (CCC).
6. Patients who require Ventilator support.
7. Pregnant women:
 - a. Within 10 days of Expected Date of Delivery (EDD).
 - b. Post-operative patient within 7 days.
 - c. High risk pregnancy seeking hospitalization.
8. COVID-19 in Paediatric age groups as per the attending doctor's opinion after clinical evaluation.
9. Attending doctor clinically evaluates & opines for admission duly considering high risk for severe disease or Mortality.

RT-PCR COVID-19 Negative

1. Symptomatic with HRCT Chest showing COVID-19 lesions: CO-RADS ≥ 4 AND CT severity score $\geq 8/25$
